Classroom Work: Session 1: June 1 - June 4: 8:00 - 4:00 (Tues., Wed., Thur., Fri.) Not Available - FULL

Session 2: <u>June 7 - June 10</u>: 8:00 – 4:00 (Mon., Tues., Wed., Thur.)

Driving sessions: June 11 - July 17 (As many times as needed scheduled around your other

activities). Additional later dates can be scheduled as needed, especially if

weather days happen. Students turning 16 first will be assigned driving times 1st.

Driving times: 8:00 - 11:00, 11:00 - 2:00 and some days will have 2:00 to 5:00 (3 people each session). The signup for driving times will be made available during the week of classroom instruction. Our instructor is certified to give the driving test. Please let the instructor know of any underlying health situations that might affect the driving portion of the class. If you pass the driving part of the class, you will not have to take the driving test at the DMV. Please be aware that taking the class does not mean that you automatically pass the driver exam. When in the driver education car, we will follow the ADPH guidelines for social distancing.

Information sheet for parent and parental permission form

THE STUDENT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERION TO RECEIVE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE CERTIFICATE:

- 1. Have a valid Alabama learner's license.
- 2. Have a signed parental permission form on file in order to participate.
- 3. Successfully fulfill all the skill requirements as set forth by DPS and SDE.
- 4. Successfully complete Driver Education.

REMINDERS CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATES:

- 1. There will be no replacement certificates issued.
- The certificate is not valid until the student turns sixteen years of age and has held a learner's license for at least six months.
- Once the student turns sixteen and has held a learner's license for six months they may take the DPS/SDE
 certificate, along with their learner's license, to the DPS office (not the probate office) and obtain a
 driver's license.
- 4. The certificate cannot be laminated or altered in any manner.
- Passing Driver Education does not guarantee that the student will receive the DPS/SDE driver's license certificate.
- 6. The certificate is not a valid document to use in lieu of a driver's license.
